



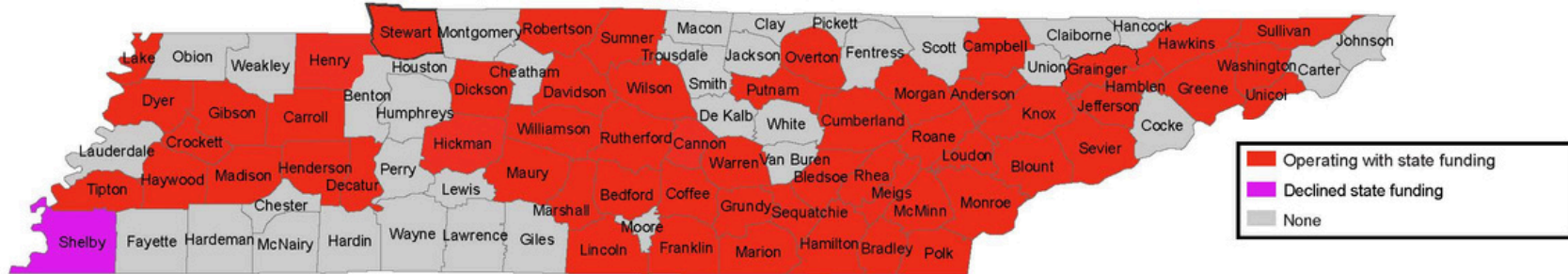

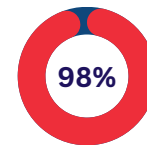
2025 Tennessee CASA Program Quick Facts

5,216 children served by **1,568** volunteers who donated **100,678** hours of service.

This is a **24%** increase in new children appointed a CASA volunteer, **9.2%** increase in new volunteers trained and taking juvenile court appointments, and **18%** increase in volunteer hours.



85% of juvenile court judges who have a CASA program reported that a CASA volunteer's involvement had a positive impact on permanency.



98% of CASA children have the same volunteer throughout their case, providing consistent, caring support as a trusted adult in their lives.
